LAKE A MEETING

MEETING PURPOSE

The project applicant, RMC Pacific Materials, LLC, a wholly owned entity of CEMEX (CEMEX), proposes to recommence reclamation activities at Lake A as part of a reclamation plan amendment for SMP-23, Eliot Quarry, within a portion of unincorporated Alameda County, California. CEMEX proposes to amend the current SMP-23 reclamation plan because changes in circumstances at the site and in applicable regulatory requirements have required the preparation of an amended reclamation plan. One of the elements of the reclamation plan amendment is to reclaim Lake A with limited earthmoving and no additional mining.

While CEMEX had previously proposed recommencing mining Lake A, based on management decisions and input from the community, CEMEX no longer proposes mining in Lake A. However, CEMEX is still required to complete reclamation pursuant to the State Surface Mining and Reclamation Act (SMARA) and County code, and the proposed reclamation activities will require limited earthmoving. The earthmoving and installation of reclamation water conveyance facilities for future operation by the Zone 7 Water Agency is anticipated to be conducted in 2022 and 2023 if the County approves the proposed reclamation plan amendment. CEMEX is not proposing additional mining, and the reclamation activities are intended to prepare Lake A for a transfer to the Zone 7 Water Agency. The County determined that this meeting will help educate agencies and the public regarding the proposed reclamation activities in the Lake A area.

RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES

NO ADDITIONAL MINING IN LAKE A

Lake A is a mined area located north of Vineyard Avenue, between Isabel Avenue/SR 84 and Vallecitos Road. Mining in the Lake A area continued until approximately 2003, when CEMEX's predecessors-in-interest discontinued mining to address neighborhood concerns caused by a subsurface slide. All Lake A slopes are currently 2:1 (horizontal to vertical) or flatter with maximum depths of 100 feet below ground surface (bgs). Lake A has not been mined to the full extent anticipated in the approved reclamation plan. No further mining is planned in Lake A.

PROPOSED RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES AT LAKE A

Lake A reclamation activities will include:

- installation of a surface water diversion from the Arroyo Del Valley (ADV) to Lake A,
- conversion of a berm that is currently located in Lake A that blocks water to a small island to allow water to flow across the lake,
- installation of a water conveyance pipeline from Lake A to future Lake C (located off-site to the northwest),
- construction of an overflow outlet to allow water to flow back into ADV when Lake A water levels are high to prevent flooding in the localized area,
- regrade and fill percolation ponds between Lake A and the ADV, and
- perform landscaping and revegetation.

The final surface area of Lake A will be 81 acres as compared to 208 acres in the currently approved reclamation plan for SMP-23.
